World Book Day 2022

At St. Patrick's, we love to celebrate everything related to books and reading and so we are looking forward to World Book Day, which will be celebrated on **Thursday 3rd March**.

As part of our theme, *Wonderful Words*, we are inviting children to dress as an adjective (a describing word) of their choice! For example, for the word 'vivid,' your child could choose to dress in bright colours or for the word, 'dishevelled,' they could come with messy hair or ripped clothes. Please do not feel that it is necessary to purchase a costume. In fact, we hope that by taking this approach, we can encourage the use of clothes already available at home and avoid any extra cost to parents, while remaining as environmentally friendly as possible. We are sure that children will have lots of ideas about which adjectives they could use, but in case anyone would like some inspiration, a list of ideas has been included at the end of this letter.

Y3 will also be participating in an additional reading initiative alongside other schools within the BWCET.

We will also be using the day to launch our whole school reading challenge, which will last until the return to school after the Easter holidays (return date Monday 25th April). Every child will be given a challenge sheet, consisting of a number of reading challenges. (For example, read a story about an animal). Children will be encouraged to obtain sponsorship from friends and family in order to complete as many reading challenges as possible during the time. The money raised will be used to purchase new books for our class libraries. Details of this reading challenge will follow.

We realise you have already been very generous in your response to our current eco-warriors fundraising challenge, which is taking place this week. It looks like we may well surpass our original target so we might already be able to redirect some of these funds to purchase books. Please do not feel under any pressure to give more if you have already given what you can.

On World Book Day, children will also take home a £1 book voucher. These can be exchanged for one of the 2022 £1 books at a number of shops, including Tesco, Sainsbury's, Waterstones and WH Smith. A list of the books available has been included at the end of this letter.
