As part of their work on our topic of coal mining, which will take place next half term, we are planning a Year 4 visit to Beamish Museum on **Friday 18th March**. The focus of the visit will be the coalmine and pit village and the children will take part in a mock pit explosion!

The trip will take place within the usual school day. Pupils will need to bring a packed lunch with a drink (no fizzy drinks or glass bottles, please) and come to school wearing sensible footwear, suitable for walking. Uniform is not necessary but, as the museum is set out around a large outdoor site, a waterproof coat will be needed. If your child receives free school meals you can order a free packed lunch via the office up to Friday 4th March via emailing stpd@stpd.bwcet with a choice of ham, cheese or tuna sandwich on white or brown bread.

We please ask for a payment of £14.00 towards entry to the museum, travel and the explosion workshop available via ParentPay in instalments. Please contact Mrs Burgess if you will have difficulty making this payment. Instead of returning a consent slip we are trying to work in a more environmentally friendly way and request that you please log on to ParentPay and tick to confirm your consent to the trip and make an initial payment.
