


Brighten Up for CAFOD!

Dear Parent/Carer,

This Harvest we are supporting CAFOD and joining other schools around the country by **brightening up!**

Did you know that one in three people around the world do not have enough safe and healthy food, all year round? This is not fair and it is not right. We will be joining other schools in building a brighter world for everyone.



To raise money, we're going to hold a bright bake sale! Each week for this half term on a Monday a different year group (apart from Reception) will take responsibility for bringing in cakes to sell. On the Monday allocated to your child's year group we encourage your child to come dressed in bright colours of their choice. It will be uniform as normal for the rest of the school. Please note due to next Monday being a bank holiday for the Queen's funeral **Y6** will hold their sale on **Tuesday** 20th September. Please see your child's allocated day below:

Please don't feel any need to buy or make any particular types or quantities of cake. Whatever you can donate for this event will be gratefully received.

The cakes will be sold for 25p each at first break. The children may buy and eat up to 2 cakes on the day as well as purchase two additional cakes, if they would like, to have at home. With this in mind, for each Monday while the events are running each pupil would be permitted to bring a small box to transport any purchased cakes home. This will hopefully avoid any squashed edibles! Please be assured there is no expectation to buy cakes, only that they will be available should the children wish to buy them.
