Year 1 & Year 4 Beamish Museum Trip

Dear Parents/Carers,

We are planning a visit to Beamish Museum on **Wednesday 29th March** for our Year 1 & Year 4 children. Our Year 1 class will, attend the workshop, 'All our Childhood Toys.' This will support their class topic of toys and schools in the past, which will take place next term.

The focus of Year 4's visit will be the coal mine and pit village. This will further their knowledge on their class history topic of coal mining.

The trip will take place within the normal school day and usual drop off and collection times will apply. Children may come dressed in warm non-uniform clothes, with sensible footwear for walking and a waterproof coat. Children will require a small rucksack to transport their lunch in on the day and a bottle of water.

School can provide a free packed lunch for all Year 1 pupils, and those pupils in Year 4 who are in receipt of free school meals. If you would like your Year 4 child to receive a school packed lunch and you currently pay for school meals, the charge will be added to ParentPay in the usual way.

Please see the forms section on your Weduc account for the trip lunch form. Please complete and indicate if your child requires a school made packed lunch, or if you will be providing one for them (sandwich options are indicated on the form).

If you have more than one child attending the trip, please complete one form per child. Please contact the school office if you experience any difficulties completing the form.

Please complete the lunch form by 9am Thursday 9th March, to order your child a school made packed lunch.
